Perform tasks involving physical labor at mine sites. May operate a variety of hand and power tools. May clean and prepare areas, assist with face setup, underground housekeeping, operate trucks, and remove waste materials.

Maintain a clean job site: pick up all tools and equipment and secure site each day in order to eliminate potential hazards.

Ensure that proper safety and incident reporting procedures are followed. Bring problems to the attention of the Superintendent, Project Manager or other site supervisory personnel

Assist miners in heading preparation, mucking, utility installation, ground support, equipment maintenance, and other underground functions

Use a variety of tools and equipment such as power mine equipment, measuring devices, trucks, etc.

Assist in all underground production and maintenance

Operate and/or assist with mine pump maintenance and installation

Willingness and ability to perform manual work following verbal and written instructions.

Required to inspect the site for safety compliance, including all PPE

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS

EDUCATION and/or EXPERIENCE

Minimum of a High School diploma or equivalent is highly desired, and 1-2 years of underground mining experience.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to stand, walk, talk, and hear.
